Tomatoes are divided into two different but important groups:

Determinate – Sometimes called bush tomatoes; these tomatoes have a relatively concentrated fruit set, meaning you harvest tomatoes only for 2 – 3 weeks. This is great for canning when you need a large crop in a short period. They can be planted closer together and usually do not need support.

<u>Indeterminate</u> – These tomatoes set fruit all season long so you have an extended harvest. They are very tall growing and require support.

Ox-heart Type – Heart shaped and very meaty.

Abe Lincoln - 87 days, red, meaty to 1 lb, few seeds, indeterminate, Heirloom

Ace-V.F. - 80-85 days red, 8 oz, good canner, good disease resistance, determinate.

Amish Paste - 85 days, pinkish-red, paste type, 8 oz, indeterminate Heirloom

Beefsteak – 82 days, red, 1 lb, good slicer, indeterminate.

Better Boy-V.F.N. – 70 days, red, to 1 lb, good disease resistance, indeterminate.

<u>Big Rainbow</u> – 80 – 85 days, very large orange fruits with red streaks. Firm, meaty flesh with low acidity, indeterminate, **Heirloom**

Black Cherry – 65 days, round black, great for salads, indeterminate

Black Krim - 75 - 90 days, dark brown red, large, heavy producer, indeterminate, Heirloom

Black Plum - 82 days, small-elongated mahogany fruit, indeterminate Heirloom

<u>Box Car Willie</u> – 80 Days, very heavy crop, red fruit, long season, 6 – 10 oz, indeterminate. **Heirloom**

Brandywine - 88 days, large red, 14 oz, indeterminate, **Heirloom**

Bull's Heart - 87 days, pink ox-heart type, 2 lbs, indeterminate, Heirloom

<u>Burpee Super Sauce Hybrid</u> – 70 days, 2 lb, seedless, good flavor and good for sauce, indeterminate

<u>Carolina Gold</u> – 71 days, extra large golden yellow fruit, disease and crack resistant, determinate

<u>Caspian Pink</u> – 80 days, pink, 14 oz, indeterminate, **Heirloom**, flavor rivals Brandywine <u>Celebrity</u> – 65 – 70 days, red, 7 oz, large, determinate

Champion – 62 days, red, 10 oz, sets fruit even in hot weather, indeterminate

<u>Chef's Choice Orange Hybrid</u> – 75 days, orange, 9-12 oz, great disease resistance, indeterminate

<u>Cherokee Purple</u> – 80 – 90 days, heavy producer of unusual pink-purple fruits with no cracking, indeterminate, **Heirloom**

<u>Cherry Red</u> – 72 days, red, small round fruit, good in hanging baskets, indeterminate <u>Costoluto Genovese</u> – 78 days, large red, deep ribbed, does well in hot weather, indeterminate, **Heirloom**

Early Girl – 52 days, red, 5 oz, good producer, indeterminate

Fantastic – 56 days, 6 oz., red, indeterminate

Fourth of July - Extra early 49 days, 4 oz, rich flavor, high yielding, indeterminate

German Johnson – 80 – 90 days, large red, indeterminate, **Heirloom**.

<u>Grape tomato</u> – 55 days, long clusters of small tomatoes shaped like seedless grapes, rich sweet flavor, disease resistant, indeterminate

Green Zebra – 75 days, amber green with darker green stripes, 3 oz, indeterminate, **Heirloom**

<u>Jetsetter</u> – 64 days, red, 8 oz or larger, lots of disease resistance, indeterminate

<u>Lemon Boy</u> – 72 days, yellow, 8 oz. or more, indeterminate

Mortgage Lifter – 83 days, red, large 1 pound fruit, meaty, indeterminate

<u>Mr. Stripey</u> – 80 days, large red fruit with orange/yellow stripe, indeterminate, **Heirloom**

New Girl – 62 days, red, 4 – 6 oz. Better flavor and disease resistance than Early Girl, indeterminate

Patio - 68 days, red, 4 oz., compact. For Patio Tubs, determinate

<u>Paul Robeson</u> – 75 days, reddish brown, medium size, indeterminate, **Heirloom**

Pineapple – 85 days, bicolor red & yellow, up to 2 pounds, indeterminate, Heirloom

Roma – 75 days, red 3 – 4 oz, plum type, good for making paste, heavy producer, determinate

<u>San Marzano</u> – 80 days, bright red, rectangular, pear shape, 3 ½" long, canning paste type, indeterminate

<u>Sunchocola</u> – 67 days, $1\frac{1}{2}$ oz, $1^{\prime\prime}$ round, large cherry type, great flavor, indeterminate, **Heirloom**

<u>Sun Sugar</u> – 62 days, golden sweet cherry-type, resists cracking, indeterminate, **our favorite**

Supersteak – 80 days, red, one pound, good disease resistance, indeterminate

<u>Sweet 100</u> – 65 days, red, small fruit, but very heavy producer, extremely sweet, indeterminate

Sweet Cluster – 67 days, clusters of 6 – 8 red, 4 oz fruit, indeterminate

Sweet Million – 60 days, cherry type, 1 – 1 ½", indeterminate.

Tomatillo – 80 days, green, used to make salsas and Mexican sauces, heavy producer

Yellow Pear - 76 days, yellow, small pear-shape, heavy producer, indeterminate
